Phase I

May 2026

The CTS search engine goes live this May, creating a central digital harbor for the global tall ship community. We are moving away from fragmented searches and bringing every major vessel into one clear, easy-to-use platform.

Our priority is working directly with you—the operators. We aren't here to guess your specs; we are inviting you to provide the itineraries, technical details, and photography that best represent your ships. You maintain full control over your information to ensure accuracy across the board.

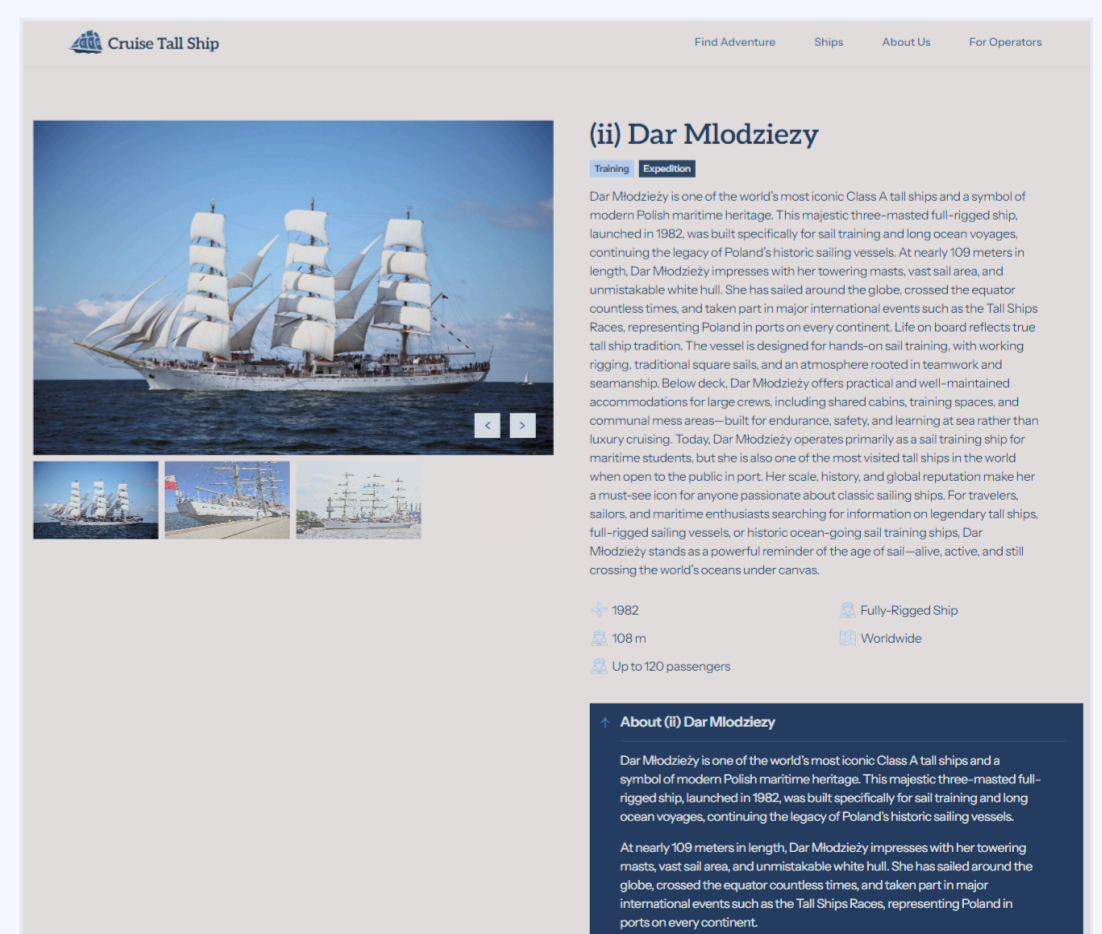
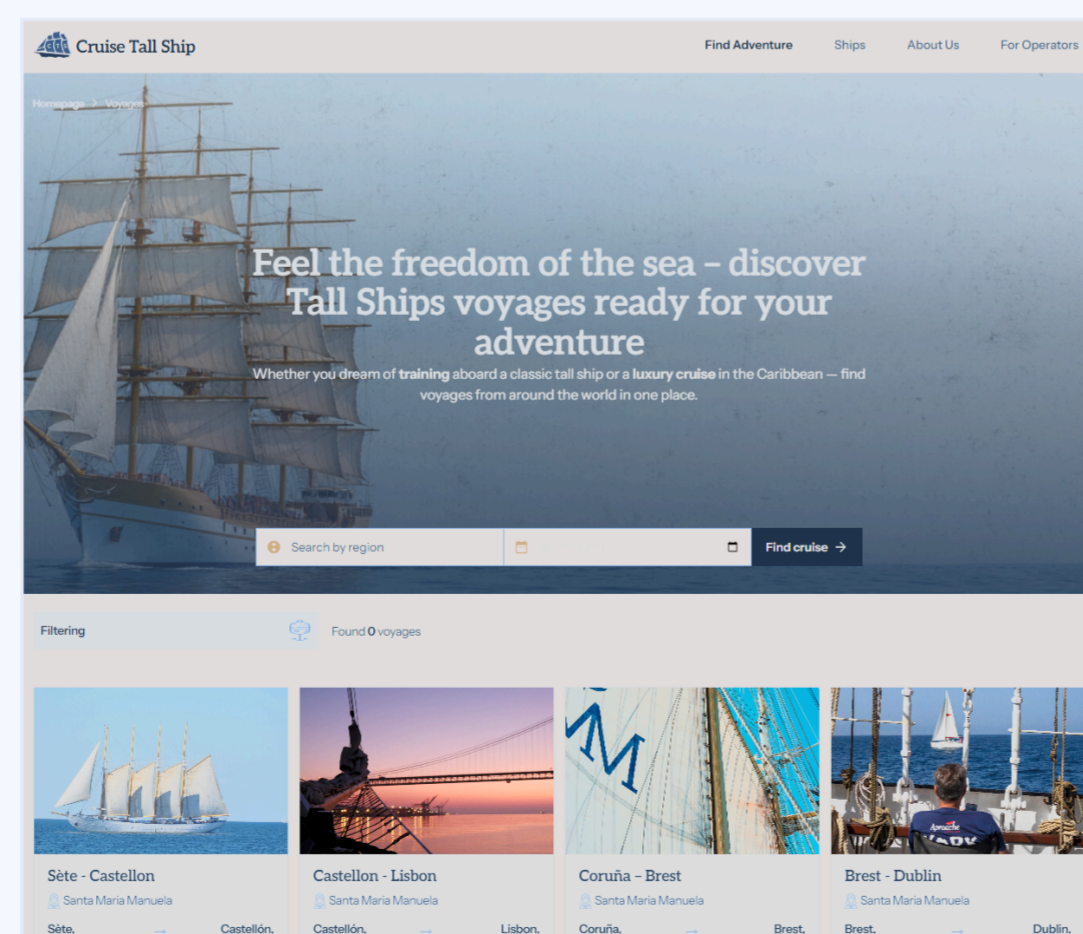
What is in it for you?

Phase II

October 2026

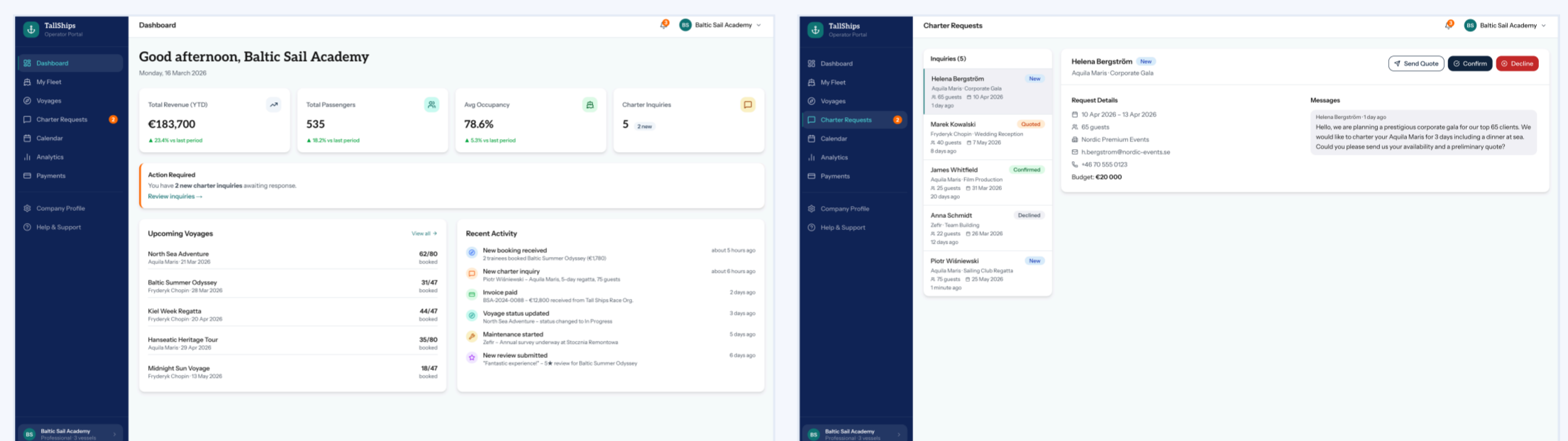
What is in it for you?

March 2027
